MARBLEHEAD-TO-HALIFAX OCEAN
RACE
-- 2007 --
DOUBLEHANDED TROPHIES.**

The following information has been extracted from the Notice of Race.

For the 2007 race, we are again offering trophies for doublehanded crews with the best combined score in PHRF Racing and IRC Divisions over the course.

Doublehanded entries must have completed an offshore passage of a minimum of 90 nautical miles and of not more than 3 legs prior to June 30, 2007. The captain and crew must be the same individuals as entered in this race. The MHORC will accept as compliance a previously sailed doublehanded race of at least 90 nautical miles which the yacht and crew completed within the last three years. The MHORC, however, reserves the right to refuse any doublehanded entry into the Race without prejudice.

Doublehanded entrants are permitted to use mechanical and electro-mechanical steering devices.

One member of the crew of Doublehanded entrants must be on watch at all times.
