DOUBLEHANDED

In The
PHRF Racing and IRC Divisions

For the 2011 race, we are again offering trophies for the double handed crews with the best corrected times over the course. The Bras D'Or Lakes trophy will be awarded PHRF Racing Division and the Trustee Bowl for the IRC Division.

Doublehanded entries must have completed an offshore passage of a minimum of 90 nautical miles and of not more than 3 legs prior to June 30, 2011. The captain and crew must be the same individuals as entered in this race. The MHORC will accept as compliance a previously sailed doublehanded race of at least 90 nautical miles which the yacht and crew completed within the last three years. The MHORC however, reserves the right to refuse any doublehanded entry into the Race without prejudice.

Doublehanded entrants are permitted to use mechanical and electro-mechanical steering devices.

One member of the crew of Doublehanded entrants must be on watch at all times.

In the 2009 race the Bras D'Or trophy was won by *Jaded*, skippered by Peter Rugg while the Trustee Bowl was won by *Dawn Treader*, skippered by Lawrence Cohen.
